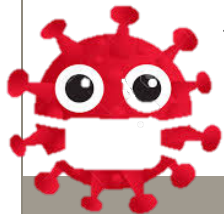
The last six months have exposed and magnified long standing inequities -- in our communities, in our hospitals, in our workplaces, and in schools.

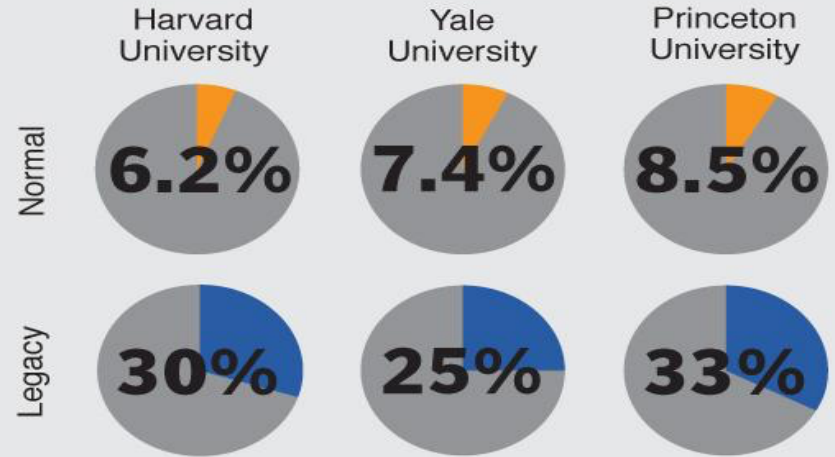

A comparison between overall acceptance rates and acceptance rates of legacy applicants in 2011



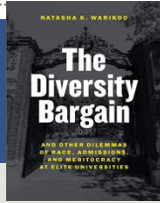

SOCIAL CAPITAL (Robert Putnam, 1993)



The central premise of social capital is that social networks have value. Social capital refers to the collective value of all “social networks” [who people know] and the inclinations that arise from these networks to do things for each other [“norms of reciprocity”].

- Moral obligations and norms
- Social values (esp trust, “brave reciprocity”)
- Social networks (esp voluntary associations)

- They offer unparalleled educations
- But, these graduates would be successful wherever they went

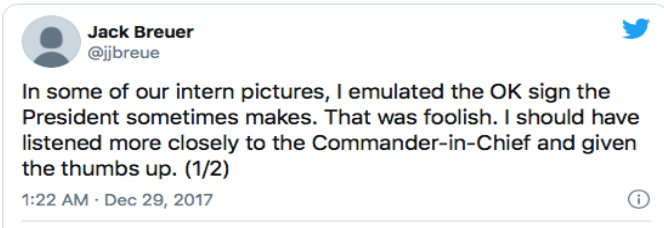

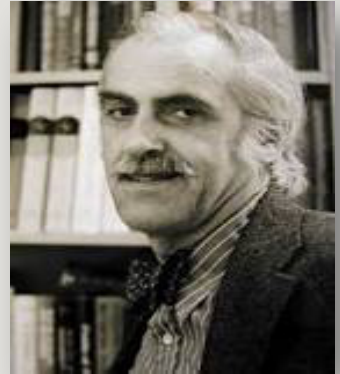
David McClelland's Three Needs Theory (1960)



Power (influence, position, responsibility, control, competition)

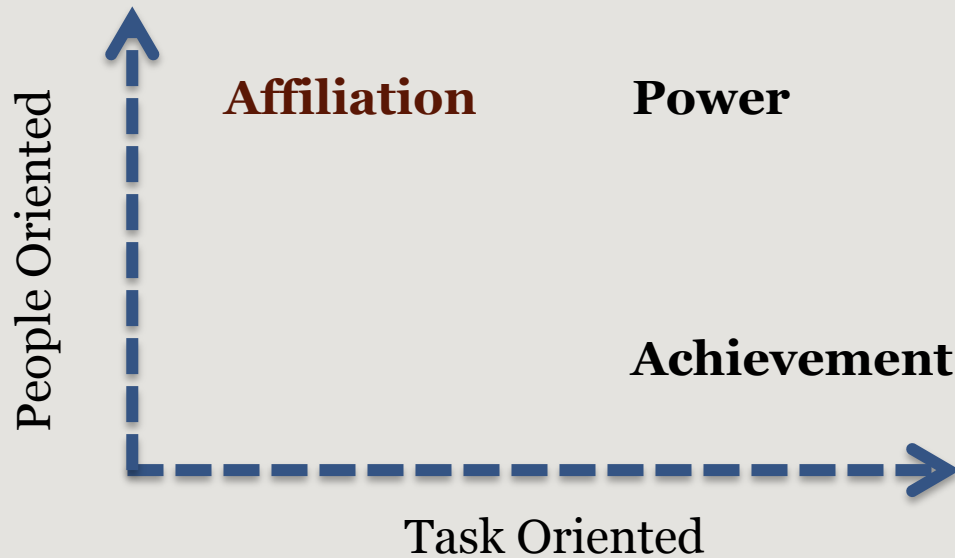

David McClelland's Three Needs Theory (1960)



Affiliation/Relatedness

1. I really like the people I interact with
2. I get along well with people I come into contact with
3. I pretty much keep to myself and don't have a lot of social contacts.
4. I consider the people I regularly interact with to be my friends
5. People in my life care about me
6. There are not many people that I am close to
7. The people I interact with regularly do not seem to like me much
8. People are generally pretty friendly towards me

McClelland's Human Motivation Theory



Power

(influence, position, responsibility, control)

Achievement

(effort over luck, accomplishment, master complex tasks)

Affiliation

(satisfaction of relationships)

McClelland's research showed that 86% of the population are dominant in one, two, or all three of these three types of motivation.

Top management positions had a high need for **power** and a low need for affiliation.

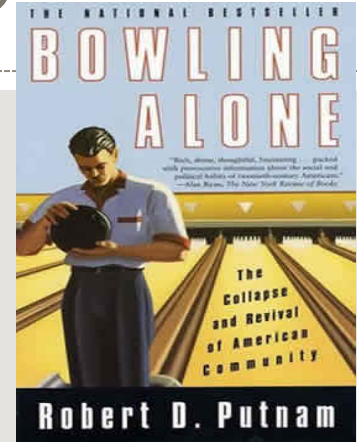
People with a high need for **achievement** will do best when given projects where they can succeed through their own efforts. Although individuals with a strong need for achievement can be successful lower-level managers, they are usually weeded out before reaching top management positions.

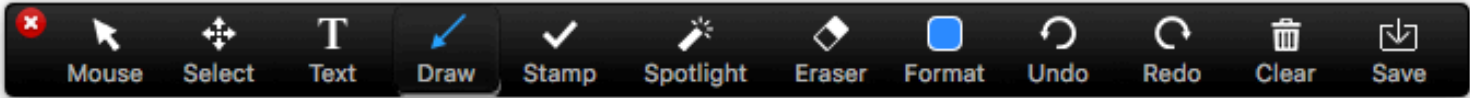
People with a high need for **affiliation** may not be good top managers but are generally happier, and can be highly successful in non-leadership roles such as the foreign service.

Declining Social Capital (Putnam, 2000)



- Joining and participating in one group cuts in half your odds of dying next year.
- Every ten minutes of commuting reduces all forms of social capital by 10%.
- Watching commercial entertainment TV is the only leisure activity where doing more of it is associated with lower social capital.
- Declining Social Capital: Trends over the last 25 years
 - Attending club meetings 58% drop
 - Family dinners 43% drop
 - Having friends over 35% drop

- 5% of people affected by Hurricane Ike in 2008 met the criteria for major depressive disorder in the month after the hurricane.
- 1 in 10 adults in New York City showed signs of major depressive disorder in the month following the 9/11 attacks.
- Nearly 25% of New Yorkers reported using more alcohol after the attacks.
- The earlier SARS epidemic was linked with increases in PTSD stress, and psychological distress in patients and health care workers.

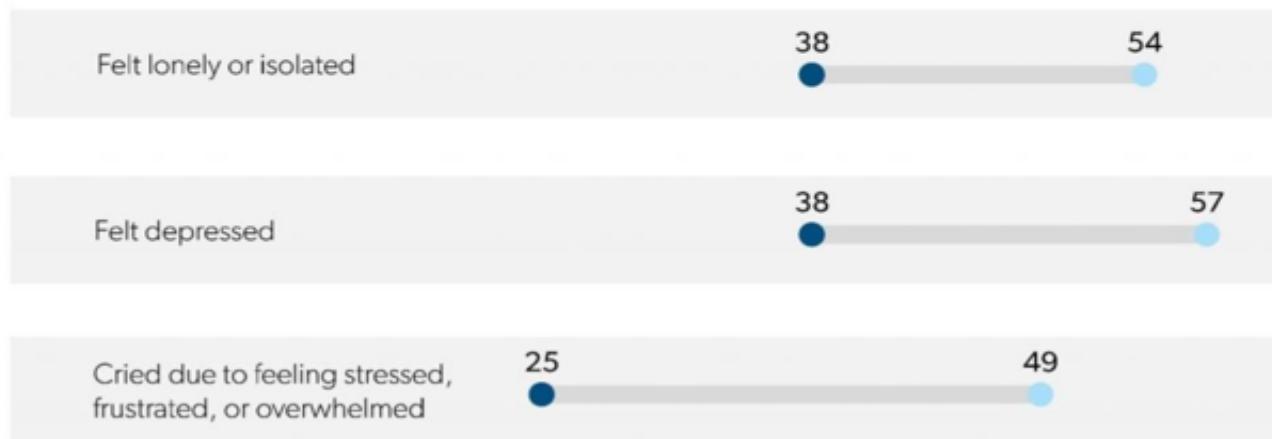

Maintain Social Contact



“First, it is necessary to plan for the inevitability of loneliness and its sequelae as populations physically and socially isolate and to develop ways to intervene.

The use of **digital technologies** can bridge social distance, even while physical distancing measures are in place.

Normal structures where people congregate, whether places of worship, or gyms, and yoga studios, can **conduct online activities** on a schedule similar to what was in place prior to social distancing.

Some workplaces are creating **virtual workspace** where people can work and connect over video connections, so they are not virtually alone. Employers should ensure that each employee receives **daily outreach** during the work week, through a supervisor or buddy system, just to maintain social contact.”

Contrary to the hopes of some advocates, the internet is not changing the socio-economic character of civic engagement in America.

Just as in offline civic life, **the well-to-do and well-educated are more likely than those less well off to participate** in online political activities such as emailing a government official, signing an online petition or making a political contribution.

Political activity is highly correlated with income, whether that activity takes place online or offline

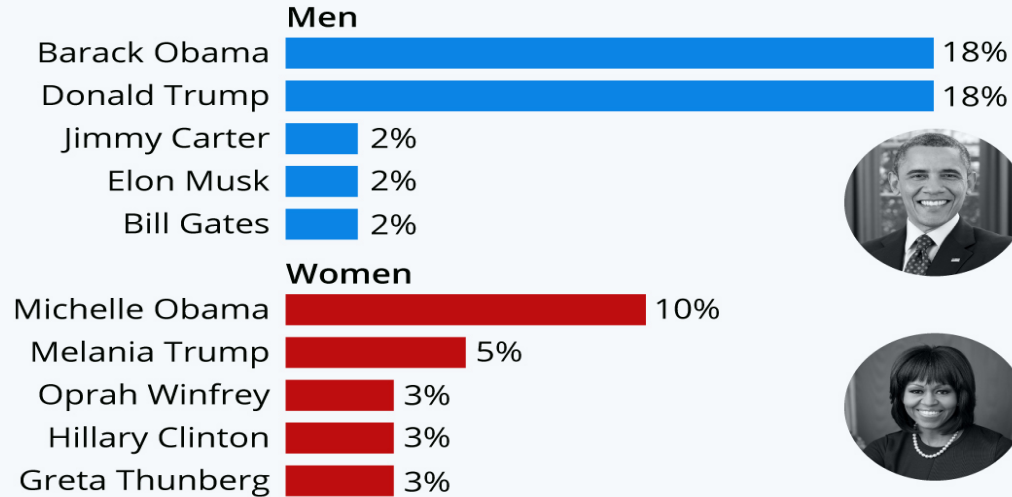
