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#### What to Record

- Physical assets that could be destroyed, damaged, or stolen
- Why?
  - Sufficient insurance coverage
    - Does your policy say 75% of the dwelling coverage, or 50%? Is that enough? Movers typically insure by weight. Is that enough?
  - Insurance claim
  - Remote access to data
- · Consider a separate inventory of:
  - Account numbers (bank, investments, credit cards)
  - Contact info (doctors, attorney, insurance, ICE contacts)
  - Social media user IDs and passwords

# What do Insurance Companies Require for a Claim?

- Ask your insurance agent
  - Photos and/or video
  - List of items
  - Replacement cost of items
  - Receipts for "big ticket" items
  - Appraisals for valuable items

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#### How Detailed Should it Be?

- · Depends on you and your purpose
- · Case studies
  - Insurance/in case of damage or loss
  - $\boldsymbol{-}$  Local or long-distance move
  - Overseas government assignment
  - Corporate move
  - Redecorating (updating inventory)
  - Valuable artwork
  - Valuable jewelry
  - Divorce
  - Death (distribution of estate assets)

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
## Questions to Ask Yourself

- What is the purpose of my inventory?
- Cloud or on my own computer?
- How detailed do I want it?
- What info does my insurance agent require?
- Do I also want a record of key contacts and financial account numbers?

#### What to Include

Besides the item name, you can include:

- · Brand name
- Model number
- Description
- Where and when purchased
- · Cost of purchase
- · Replacement value
- Serial number on electronics
- Other info:
  - Size for artwork, area rugs, computer/TV screens  $\,$
  - $-\ Warranties, maintenance\ contracts, instruction\ manuals$

#### Can You Just Make a Video?

- Videos are recommended by some insurance companies, in addition to photos
- It's a quick easy way to record your entire inventory
- Cannot be updated; have to retake video

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
# Overview of Steps to Create Inventory

- 1. Take photos (and videos) one room at a time, using smartphone or digital camera
- Copy or move the photos and videos to your computer—Inventory folder, appropriate room subfolder
- 3. Scan receipts and other documents, naming each as you scan, and store in room subfolder
- 4. Enter the detailed information in whatever you decide to use:
  - Spreadsheet
  - Software program
  - Smartphone app

# What to Photograph

- · Complete view of each room
  - Don't forget the floor, ceiling, and window treatments!
  - $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{-}}$  Some smartphones/cameras allow panoramic photos
- Individual large items
- Small groupings
- Exterior of home/yard (lighting, landscaping)
- Cars, boats, motorcycles
- Each shelf, drawer, section of closet
- Attic, garage, outdoor shed, and off-site storage unit

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## **Tips for Photos**

- · China and silver (close ups of markings)
- Kitchen drawers and cabinets (each drawer and shelf)
- Electronics (photo also of serial number)
- Jewelry
  - Use 12" ruler next to items to show size
  - Lay out on white or black poster board
- · Closets and dresser drawers
- Medicine cabinet and bathroom drawers

Make sure you have enough space for all those digital photos!

## **Tips for Scanning**

- Name each document as you scan it
- If using a sheet-fed scanner, use a clear document carrier for small receipts
- Other important documents to scan
  - Appraisals
  - Deed to house
  - Plat
  - Car title
  - Warranties
  - Maintenance Contracts
  - Instruction manuals
  - Insurance policy

# **Scanning Options**

- · Apps for your smartphone
  - I use TurboScan for my iPhone
- Desktop (two that are highly recommended)
  - Fujitsu ScanSnap iX1500
  - Raven Pro Scanner
- What to look for—does it do?
  - Multiple page document feeder
  - Double sided scanning
  - Scanning in color or only black and white
  - $\ \mathsf{OCR} \ (\mathsf{optical} \ \mathsf{character} \ \mathsf{recognition})$

Carefully check the reviews and the features of the scanners you're considering.



## Things to Keep in Mind

- · Back up your data and back it up again
  - Multiple backups for redundancy
  - Off-site backup (safe deposit box; friend/family member, preferably not close by)
    - CD (may become obsolete)/Flash drive/external hard drive
    - Cloud
  - Export to spreadsheet or PDF file
  - Paper reports
- Don't forget to inventory your digital assets: user IDs and passwords for your computer, smartphone, social media, and financial accounts


# These are only a few of the many inventory programs available





  - Inbox where you can send digital receipts for your purchases from email, web browsers, and other apps


